
REVIEW OF UPCOMING COUNCIL MEETING AGENDAS

City Manager Kim reviewed agenda items scheduled for upcoming Council meetings.


Discussion ensued regarding topics of discussion to bring forward to the joint cities meeting. One item of interest was a 5k run.
