**Fife Council Appoints Mayor and Deputy Mayor**

**Fife, WA** –The Fife City Council reappointed councilmember Kim Roscoe as Fife City Mayor at its February 11 meeting. Roscoe has held the position of Fife’s mayor since 2017. The mayor is appointed by fellow councilmembers for a two-year term.

Councilmembers also reappointed Councilmember Lew Wolfrom to a second term as the Fife City Deputy Mayor. The deputy mayor is also appointed by fellow councilmembers and serves a one-year term.

[Mayor Roscoe](#) has served on the council several different times. She served elected terms from 2002-2009, 2016-present, and appointed terms in 2011 and 2013.

[Deputy Mayor Wolfrom](#) has served on the council since 2011 and was a school board member before he served on the council.

The Fife City Council consists of seven members, elected to four-year terms. The council serves as the legislative branch of Fife's government. They are responsible for establishing policy, voting appropriations, developing the city's vision and mission, and passing local ordinances, resolutions, and proclamations.
