ALL CITY BUILDINGS CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC

Fife, WA – The health and safety of our citizens and employees remain the highest priority for the City of Fife. In keeping with advice from public health officials, the City of Fife will close all city buildings to the public effective March 17, 2020. The City will remain open for business remotely, via email and phone, from 10 a.m. through 3 p.m. daily.

These precautions are a result of the ongoing COVID-19 health recommendations.

The building closures will be continually reevaluated by city officials and any changes will be communicated through the City of Fife's website at cityoffife.org/covid19 and through the city's social media channels (see below).

The Fife Aquatic Center and Fife Community Center were closed to the public March 13, 2020.

As with any infectious virus, this is an evolving situation. Please check the city's website at cityoffife.org for the most current information. During any outbreak, safe reliable information is important. The City of Fife recommends that citizens also consult the Tacoma-Pierce County Health Department for up-to-date health information at tpchd.org.
