Murrey's will also collect up to three 32-gallon *biodegradable* bags of yard waste on your regularly scheduled pick-up day.

### **SATURDAY, APRIL 8**

Murrey's will pick up one appliance. Accepted items include range, refrigerators, freezers, furnaces, dryers, washing machines, dishwashers, hot water tanks, trash compactors and air conditioners. No BBQ grills. Your appliance must be placed outside by 7 a.m. on April 8.

## Safety Helmet How-To

Sometimes it's good to be hard-headed—like when you're riding a bike, skateboard or scooter. You can protect your noggin and reduce your risk of serious brain injury or death by wearing a helmet every time you're rolling. For maximum protection, it's crucial to wear a helmet that fits just right. Once you've tried on a few and chosen the one that feels right, follow these tips:

- Adjust sizing pads or fit ring until the helmet is snug.
- Check the helmet sits level on your head and one or two finger-widths above your eyebrows.
- Adjust the side straps so they form a "V" shape under your ears.
- Center the buckle on the chin strap under your chin.
- Buckle and tighten the chin strap so no more than one or two fingers fit under the strap

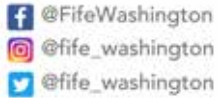

## Register Now for Camp Fife

Set your kids up for a summer of adventure, discovery, fun and friendship at Camp Fife.

Running from June 20 through Aug. 25, our day camp at Dacca Barn offers a new activities theme and two field trips each week. Planned excursions include Bellevue Botanical Gardens, Nisqually Living History Museum, a Tacoma Rainiers game, the Washington State Capital campus, a pick-your-own blueberry farm and more! Children ages 6 to 12 can be enrolled for one week, multiple weeks or all 10 weeks.

Camp Fife costs \$215 per week for Fife residents or \$235 for non-residents. (Weeks 1 and 3 are four-day weeks due to national holidays and cost \$172 for residents or \$188 for non-residents.) There is also a one-time enrollment fee of \$25.
