How is my water bill calculated?

Effective January 1, 2021, the minimum monthly rate for water supplied through meters to users within the city limits and the associated base usage amounts shall be as follows:

2" Meter	2,500 cubic feet or less	\$247.71
3" Meter	5,000 cubic feet or less	\$495.77
4" Meter	7,500 cubic feet or less	\$743.59
6" Meter	15,000 cubic feet or less	\$1,487.26
Rate per 100 Cubic Feet (Above Base Amount)		\$3.74

For every 100 cubic feet of water supplied through meters to users within the city limits in excess of the monthly base usage amounts above, \$3.74 will be charged. The formula for the Rate Adjustment is as follows:

$$[\text{Wholesale Costs as \% of Total Costs}] \times [\text{Wholesale Cost Increase}] + [\text{Other Operating Costs as \% of Total Costs}] \times [\text{Increase in Average Annual Consumer Price Index for Seattle (CPI-U: All Urban Consumers)}] + [\text{Rate-Funded Capital Costs as \% of Total Costs}] \times [\text{Increase in Average Annual Engineering News Record (ENR) Construction Cost Index for Seattle}] = \text{Indexed Rate Adjustment} + \text{Other Utility Rate adjustments}$$

Other Adopted Utility Rate Adjustments: The January 1, 2021, increase shall be the indexed rate adjustment percentage plus three percent.

2021 Calculation: $(41.60\% \times -20.15\%) + (58.40\% \times 0.87\%) + (0.0\% \times 5.63\%) = -7.88\% + 3.00\% = -4.88\%$
